## FinCEN Names Jimmy Kirby as Deputy Director

Mr. Kirby is a graduate of the University of Texas School of Law, where he was a member of the Texas Law Review, and he clerked for the Honorable Judge Barefoot Sanders of the U.S. District Court for the Northern District of Texas in Dallas. He also holds an LLM in Public International Law from University College London.
